FIFTH AMENDING AGREEMENT made effective as of this 30th day of April, 2017.

BETWEEN:

SASKATCHEWAN POWER CORPORATION ("SaskPower")

- and -

SASKATCHEWAN MINISTRY OF THE ECONOMY, PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS DIVISION (the "Ministry")

- and -

CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF OILWELL DRILLING CONTRACTORS ("CAODC")

WHEREAS:

- A. SaskPower, the Ministry and CAODC (collectively referred to as the "Parties") entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated January 31, 2014, and have extended the term of the Memorandum of Understanding by four previous amending agreements (collectively, the "MOU");
- B. The current term of the MOU will expire on April 30, 2017; and
- C. The Parties have agreed to amend the MOU in accordance with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The term of the MOU is extended to April 30, 2018.
- 2. This Fifth Amending Agreement shall amend the MOU, and the Parties confirm that, except as modified herein, the provisions of the MOU remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
- 3. This Fifth Amending Agreement may be executed in one or more counter-parts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Any party may deliver an executed copy of this Fifth Amending Agreement via electronic mail or facsimile transmission.
